You’ll join fellow orphan owners as you cruise 30 miles of scenic back roads, pausing every-so-often to visit points of interest along the route. We plan stops at the Millstone Cellars Cidery, Prigel Family Creamery, Ladew Topiary Gardens and Boordy Vineyard, but other places could be added!

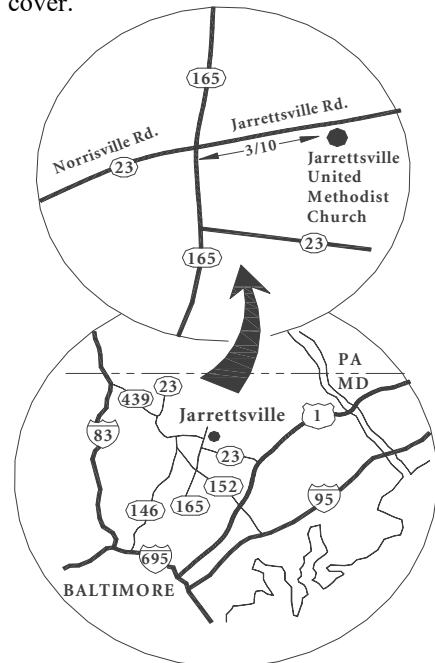
Each driver will follow printed directions, taking the route at his / her own speed.

As usual, there’s a printed quiz with diabolical questions to test your observation skills along the route! Fabulous prizes will be awarded to the most observant. (Okay, maybe the prizes aren’t fabulous, but we will find out who is the sharpest lookout!)

The choice of eligible orphans is larger than ever before, so tune one up, enlist a congenial navigator, and come on out for a fun day in seldom-seen country.

We’ll gather at 9:30 AM at the Jarrettsville United Methodist Church, with cars being released onto the tour starting at 10:30 AM. Service stations, a restaurant, and a High’s convenience store are located within 2/10 of a mile.

As always, the Tour will be held “rain or shine”. If it rains, bring an umbrella (and if necessary, drive a modern car). We’ll still have a great time and see some beautiful scenery, and a number of attractions that we’ll see are under cover.
